#### **Contributions and Charges Statements:**

The State Government through the Department of Education, provides placement at educational facilities for all students who choose to attend Government schools. The Department also pays for the wages of all teaching and non-teaching positions plus costs such as repairs, maintenance and utilities. The Government does not provide for many goods and services which students use and it is reasonable for parents to meet these costs.

Financial support provided by parents has always played a significant role in enhancing Government schools' capacity to add value to students' learning experiences. Families are advised by December each year as to the maximum costs that could be applied for the following year.

Revenue collected from your Voluntary Contributions is used to cover expenses in lower school compulsory learning areas and some elective subjects. For example, items that are subsidised by the Voluntary Contributions include textbooks, physical education equipment, technology consumables, science chemicals and photocopied materials.

Elective subjects (for example Photography, Food Production, Outdoor Education, Woodwork and Metalwork etc) attract compulsory charges for the high cost of materials and activities offered.

Specialist Programs (such as Aviation and Volleyball) also attract higher compulsory charges due to the expectations and requirements of the programs.

International Fee-paying students are charged by the College for local fees (contributions and charges), optional costs and SCSA Enrolment Fees.

Your individual Contributions and Charges statement will be issued once subject selections are finalised, statements will detail the below charges, voluntary contributions and VARS payable.

**Charges** are compulsory costs for high-cost elective subjects in lower school Years 7 to 10 and <u>all</u> course costs in upper school Years 11 and 12 as advised in the Curriculum Handbooks issued earlier in the year.

Parents of students who choose the higher charge option subjects need to consider the costs during the subject selection process. The College may also request a 50% or full confirmation charge payable before the start of the academic year.

**Voluntary contributions** cover the cost of textbook hire and materials used in non-elective courses of study in Years 7 to 10.

Other approved voluntary contributions (VARS) are used to subsidise essential school services such as the Library, Student Services, swimming pool, two school buses, P & C Association and ICT.

Set out below is an explanation of the Approved and Voluntary Requests which appear on your child's Voluntary Contributions and Charges Statements.

Technology	\$60.00	This request assists Greenwood College with replacement of over 600 computers and ICT equipment for student access across all subject areas.
Student Health and Wellbeing Initiatives	\$35.00	This VAR contributes to the implementation and running of important student health and wellbeing programs co-ordinated by Student Services such as Anti-Bullying (Zero to Hero), Tomorrow Man, DrumBeat, Rock and Water, Friendship Room and Breakfast Club.
Library	\$27.00	Revenue collected enables the library to purchase additional resources for the library.
Bus	\$20.00	Greenwood College has three school buses, which are used to transport students to school excursions, camps, sporting events, etc. Contributions are allocated to our bus replacement reserve.
Pool	\$24.00	Greenwood College has a 25m outdoor swimming pool and is used in physical education classes, as well as for whole school events. Contributions collected are allocated to our pool equipment replacement reserve.
P&C – paid once per family	\$30.00	The P&C Voluntary Parent Contribution per family is to avoid the need for all families to participate in fundraising activities throughout the year. Funds raised for the P&C are spent to benefit all students.

## Extra Proposed Excursions And Other Optional Costs By Year Group

Extra cost options (costs) are applied for optional activities such as the Yearbook, excursions, after school activities, competitions, camps and work experience etc and are only incurred should your child participate in the activity. **Payment for these items is required prior to your child participating**.

Refunds for these charges are not available once payment has been made.

It is strongly encouraged and recommended that all families consider Ambulance Cover for their child as the Department of Education does not have personal accident or ambulance service cover for students.

2024 School Photos will be held in Term 2. Families can order photos and pay online directly through the photographer once order forms have been distributed.

Replacement Smart Riders are available at Admin for a \$5 charge.

#### BYOD:

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) refers to students bringing a personally owned device (laptop) to school for the purpose of learning. In 2024 the BYOD program will be offered to Year 7, 8, 11 and 12 students. Further information regarding specifications and policies has been distributed separately to families, and are available on our website.

#### **Payment Methods:**

Wherever possible we utilise available technology to facilitate payment to the school and provide flexible and easy options to families.

#### **Payment Plans:**

#### **Collecting contributions and charges:**

The school will take a positive approach to collecting contributions from parents of students in Years 7 to 10. In particular, the school will highlight the benefits to students if all parents meet their contributions.

With respect to charges for Year 7 to 12, the school will actively seek full payment of charges. The following steps will be taken:

- Regular account statements sent home to parents.
- Parents who fail to engage in communication with the school and have made no attempt to pay charges will be referred to our debt collection agency as permitted in the regulations.
- Students whose family has a history of non-payment may be refused enrolment in high cost subjects (for example, Outdoor Education).
- High cost and specialist subjects may require a full or 50% confirmation charge paid prior to enrolment.
